

North Country Gordon Setter Club of Minnesota, Inc. Awards

2009 TITLE MEDALLION

North Country Gordon Setter Club awards medallions each year to member's dogs, regardless of breed, which have earned titles in performance events from the American Kennel Club, the Canadian Kennel Club, the United Kennel Club and the Gordon Setter Club of America. Applicants are required to be a North Country member in good standing at the time their dog earned its title, and application must be submitted for the year in which the title was earned. These medallions are not automatic. An application must be filled out and sent to the awards tabulator.

2009 FIELD TRIAL DOG OF THE YEAR

This award is to further promote the Gordon Setter as a field dog by recognizing the individual performances of our dogs. A traveling trophy purchased by NCGSC will be awarded to the winner (co-winners would each have the trophy for a 6 month period). This award may not be given out each year if the above criteria is not met by at least one applicant.

2009 OBEDIENCE AWARDS

There are two year-end awards given to recognize outstanding accomplishment in the obedience ring:

THE NCGSC NOVICE OBEDIENCE DOG OF THE YEAR
THE NCGSC ADVANCED OBEDIENCE DOG OF THE YEAR

Awards will be traveling trophies to be retained by the winner for one year and then returned to be re-awarded at the Awards dinner.

2009 AGILITY AWARDS

There are two year-end awards given to recognize outstanding accomplishment in the agility ring:

Novice Agility Dog
Advanced Agility Dog

2009 BIRD DOG AWARD

This award is based on points gained while earning AKC Hunting Test and GSCA Working Certificate legs. A traveling trophy purchased by NCGSC will be awarded to the winner (co-winners would each have the trophy for a six month period). This award may not be given out each year if the above criteria is not met by at least one applicant.

2009 CONFORMATION AWARDS

There are two year-end awards given to recognize outstanding accomplishment in the conformation ring:

THE ED COTTE MEMORIAL AWARD – TOP GORDON SETTER DOG
THE JANICE CLARK MEMORIAL AWARD – TOP GORDON SETTER BITCH

Awards will be traveling trophies to be retained by the winner for one year and then returned to be re-awarded at the Awards dinner.

To be eligible the following rules generally apply for all awards except medallions...

- ❖ Dog must be an AKC registered Gordon Setter.
- ❖ The primary owner of the dog/bitch, as registered with AKC, applying for the award must be a NCGSC member in good standing at the time points were earned. The primary owner must attend at least three NCGSC events during this calendar year, verified from the club roster book. These events include: 1) January Specialty 2) Awards Dinner 3) Spring Fun Field Day 4) Hunting Tests 5) June Specialty 6) Picnic-Auction 7) Field Trail 8) Fall General Membership Meeting.
- ❖ It is the owner's responsibility to nominate their dog for this award.
- ❖ Dog/bitch must be nominated on an official form and meet award specific criteria.
